

**The European HIV and Jaundice Testing Week** has been repeatedly organized in a number of European countries. The main goal is to provide **free testing for HIV infection**, hepatitis B and C, and syphilis. This year, there will again be events related to testing throughout the Czech Republic. The umbrella organization is the National Institute of Public Health, under the auspices of the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic. Both national and non-governmental organizations are involved in the European Testing Week.

European Testing Week is an ideal opportunity to detect HIV infection. Early detection of the infection allows for the beginning of treatment. The earlier the infection is detected, the more effectively the patient's body responds to treatment, thereby preventing undesirable complications.

Testing will take place across the Czech Republic **from November 20<sup>th</sup> to November 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023**. The event is intended for the general public. Anyone wanting the certainty that they have not been infected in the past can come.
